In partnership with Chaulden Adventure Playground we are looking to develop a youth group for young people age 10-16 who may have additional needs. The youth group will be supervised by the Adventure Playground Workers, who will provide support to enable the young people to form friendships and be in an environment where they can feel safe and comfortable. These taster sessions are available free of charge and if they prove popular, further sessions will be offered during the summer and in the autumn. Children's needs will be considered, however, the following will generally be available:

- Open unstructured sessions with freedom to roam across all activities.
- Indoor activities - table tennis, pool table, variety of board games, art & craft, cooking facilities, arcade machines and Lego.
- Outdoor activities - AstroTurf, zip wire, giant wooden castle, net swing, trampoline, basketball hoops and outdoor games.
- Tea/Coffee and snacks available for a small charge.

Staff are qualified in Level 3 Play Work and First Aid. Parents will need to register their child on arrival. There is no obligation to stay as the young people will be supervised, however parents are welcome to stay to see what facilities are available. Unfortunately due to the nature of the sessions, siblings won't be able to be accommodated.
